Ordinance #18-8

An Ordinance to Amend Chapter 375 Vehicles and Traffic Part 2 Parking To Create An Additional Employee Parking Zone On Fourth Avenue

BE IT ORDAINED by the Mayor and Council of the Borough of Westwood that Chapter 375 Vehicles and Traffic, be amended as follows (deleted sections are noted by strikethroughs, new sections are **bold and underlined**):

Section 1. Amend Chapter 375-44 Two-hour zones.

The zones described in this section shall all have up to a two-hour time limit for parking. The following named and described areas, public parking lots or portions of public parking lots, streets or portions of streets, as may hereinafter be included in this section by amendment hereto, lying within the corporate limits of the Borough of Westwood shall constitute two-hour parking meter zones:

Street	Side	Location
Fourth Avenue [Added 8-16-2016 by Ord. No. 16-20]	East	From Washington Avenue to Park Avenue
Fourth Avenue [Added 8-16-2016 by Ord. No. 16-20]	West	From Washington Avenue to Park Avenue

Section 2. Amend Chapter 375-46.1 Designated employee parking zones.

The following streets or parts of streets, and metered spaces within the municipal parking lots, are designated as employee parking zones. No person shall park a vehicle between the hours of 6:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. Monday through Saturday unless the vehicle has displayed from its rear view mirror a valid and current employee parking hang tag.

Name of Street	Side	Location
Center Avenue (North Lot) [Amended 9-5-2017 by Ord. No. 17-24]	West	In Municipal Lot B, as described in Chapter 237 , Article I , § 237-1 , the last four spaces at the north end of the eastern row, the last three spaces on each side of the center island at the north end of the center row, and the last four spaces at the north end of the western row designated as employee parking and requiring a valid and current hang tag

Name of Street	Side	Location
Fairview Avenue	East	From Bergen Street to Jefferson Avenue, designated as employee parking and requiring a valid and current hang tag
Fairview Avenue	West	From Bergen Street to Jefferson Avenue designated as employee parking and requiring a valid and current hang tag
<u>Fourth Avenue</u>	<u>West</u>	<u>From Washington Avenue to Park Avenue</u>
Madison Avenue	East	From Irvington Street, north for a distance of 360 feet, designated as employee parking and requiring a valid and current hang tag

Section 3. If any section, subsection, paragraph, sentence or any other part of this ordinance is adjudged unconstitutional or invalid, such judgment shall not affect, impair or invalidate the remainder of this ordinance.

Section 4. All ordinances or parts of ordinances which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed to the extent of such inconsistency.

Section 5. If any section, subsection, part, clause or phrase of this Ordinance shall be declared invalid by judgment of any court of competent jurisdiction, such section, subsection, part, clause or phrase shall be deemed to be severable from the remainder of this Ordinance.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final passage and publication as required by law.
